About the SPOTlight and SPREE

The **School Performance Outcomes Table (SPOTlight)** is a one-page, at-a-glance summary of school performance and improvement on key SPREE metrics.

The **School Progress Report on Education and Equity (SPREE)** is the District's accountability report to summarize school performance and progress.

- The SPREE closely aligns to the Board of Education's [Goals and Guardrails](#) and the Superintendent's Conditions for Success.
- The SPREE is released annually for the previous school year.
- Schools that serve multiple grade spans can receive two reports.

This allows for analyses to be made based on comparable grade spans.

[^] **Alternative programs do not receive a SPREE.** Instead, the annual accountability report for the Alternative program sector is the Alternative Education Progress Report (AEPR). The AEPR is a program-wide report; programs do not receive a report by grade span. The AEPR is specialized for each alternative program model and is typically released in late spring. Three transition support programs, that do not provide educational services, do not receive a report.

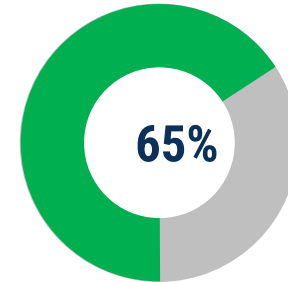

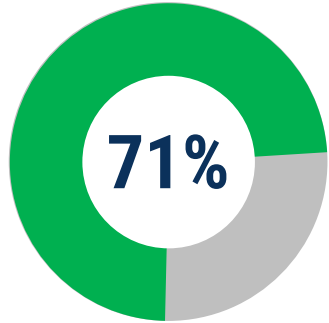

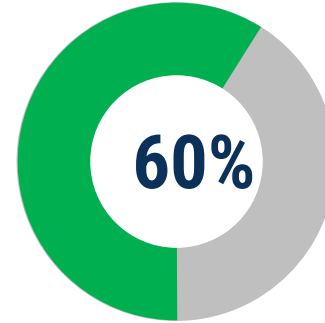

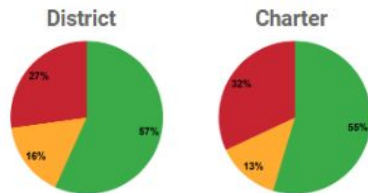

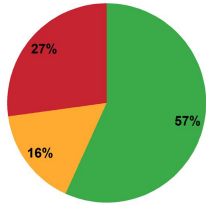

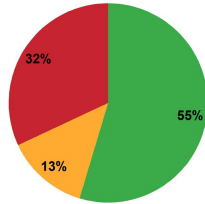
Percentage of Students Attending at Least 90% of Instructional Days

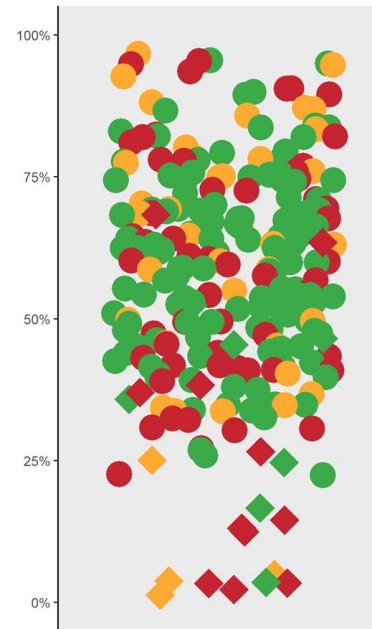

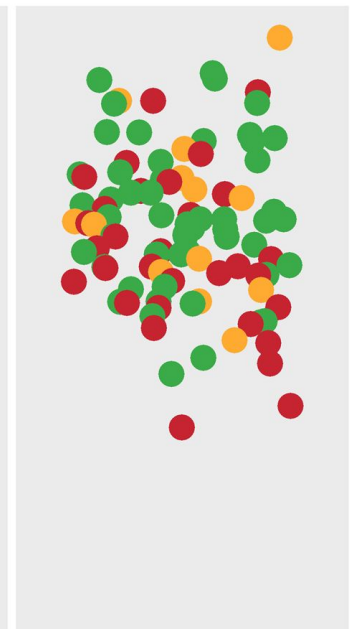

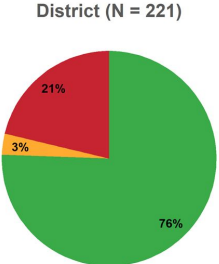

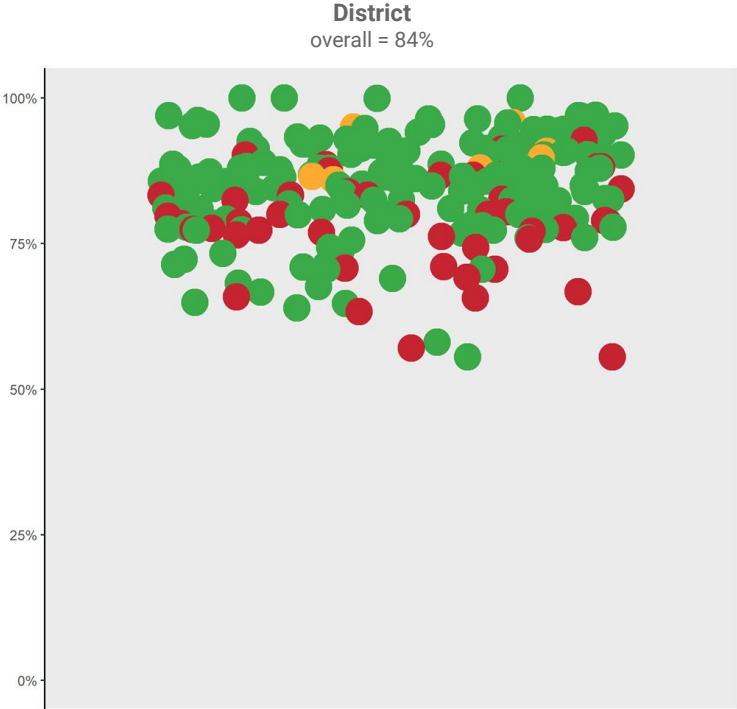
Percentage of Teachers Attending at Least 90% of Instructional Days

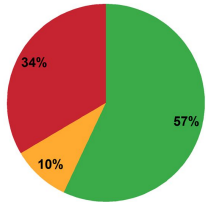

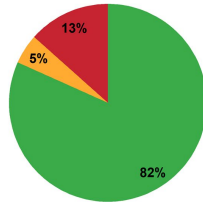
Number of Dropouts - Last School of Touch (Grades 7-12)

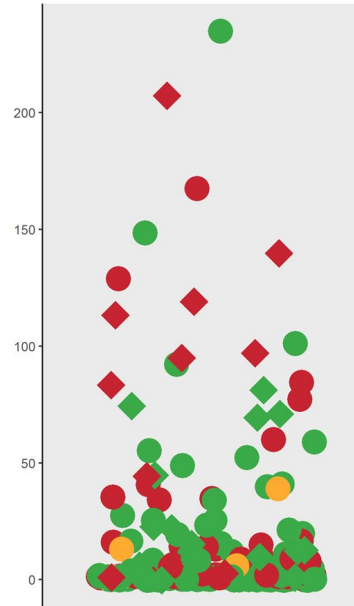

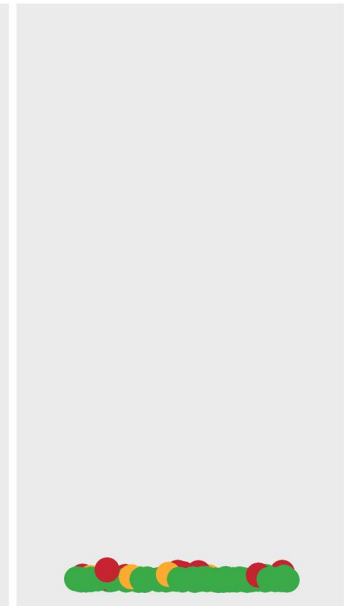


Number of students in grades 7-12 dropping out in 2022-23 by school report, with each report's status of **improving**, **maintaining**, or **not improving** indicated by dot color

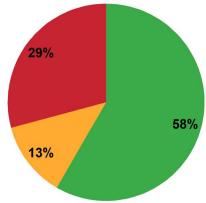

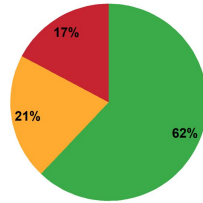
Four-Year Cohort Graduation Rate

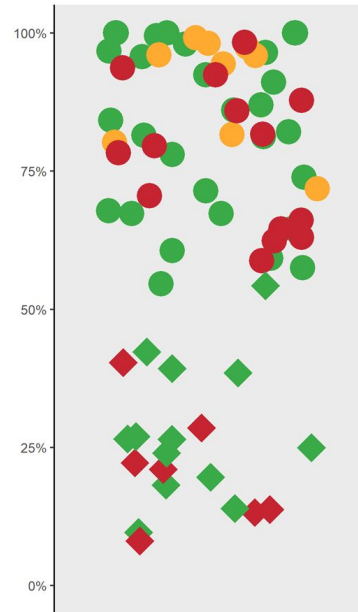

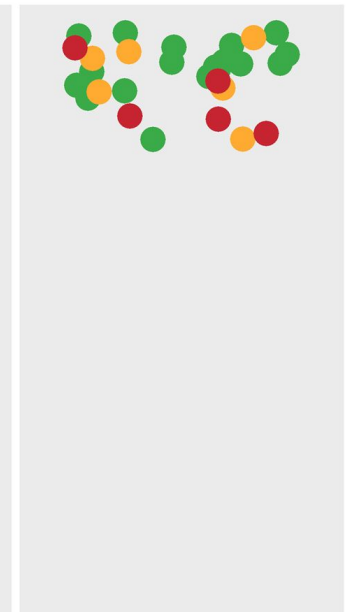

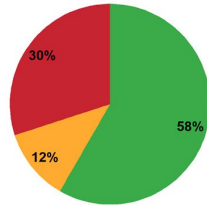
PSSA ELA: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grade 3

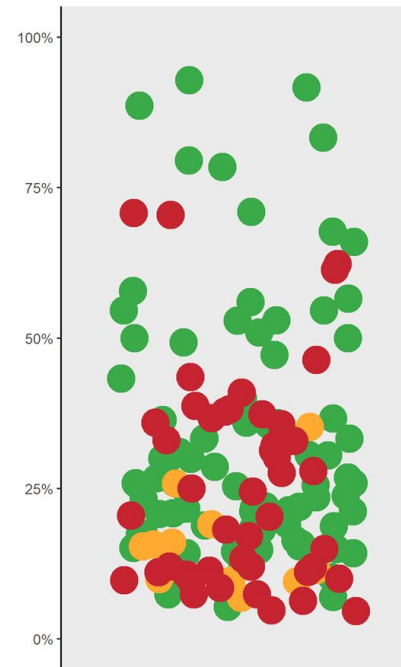

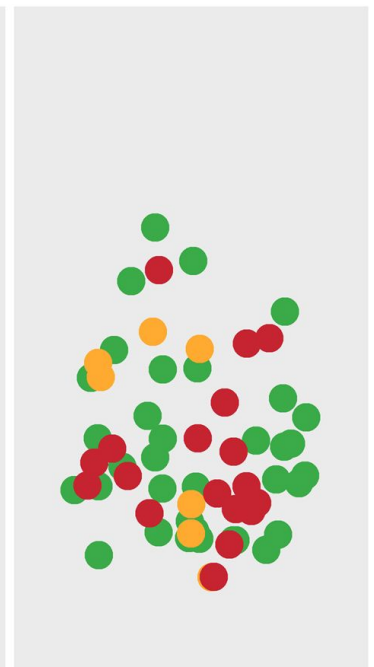

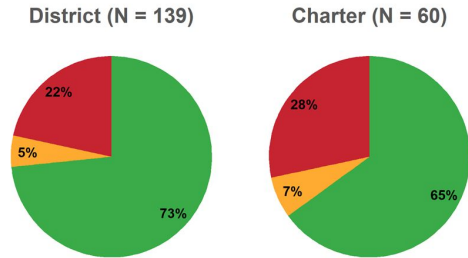

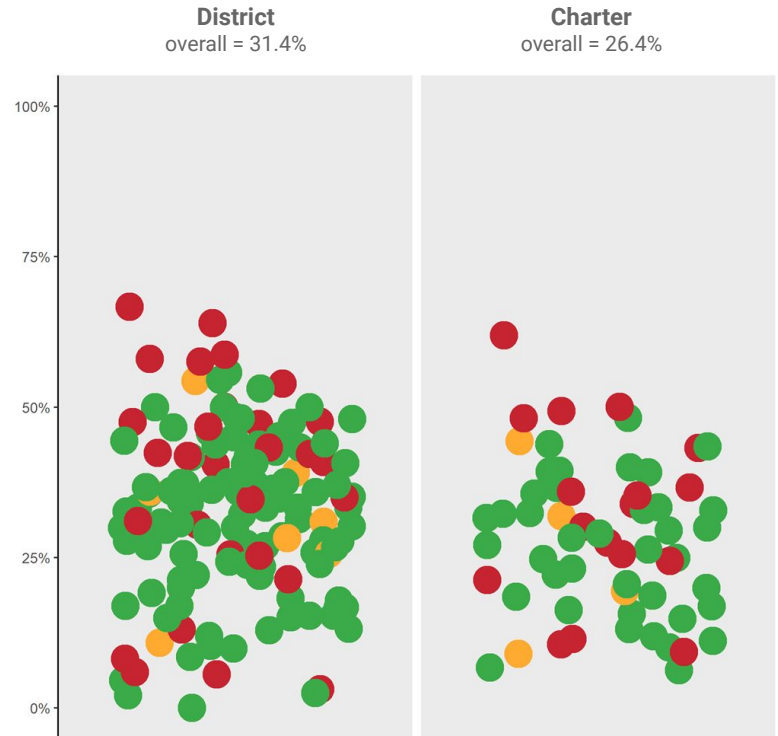

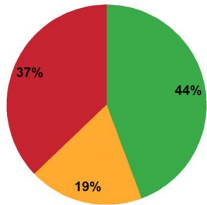

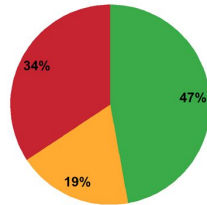
PSSA ELA: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grades 3-8

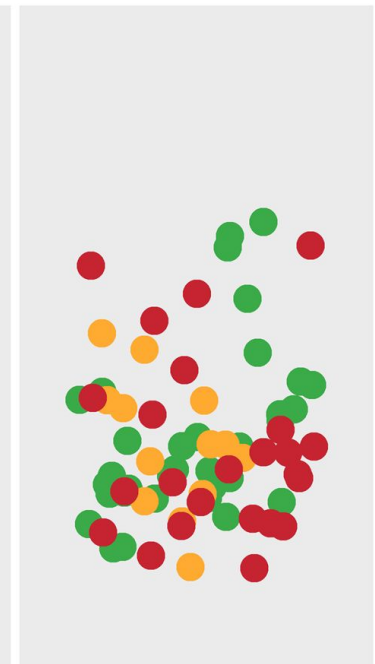

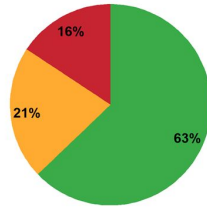
PSSA ELA: Percentage of Students Scoring Below Basic, Grades 3-8

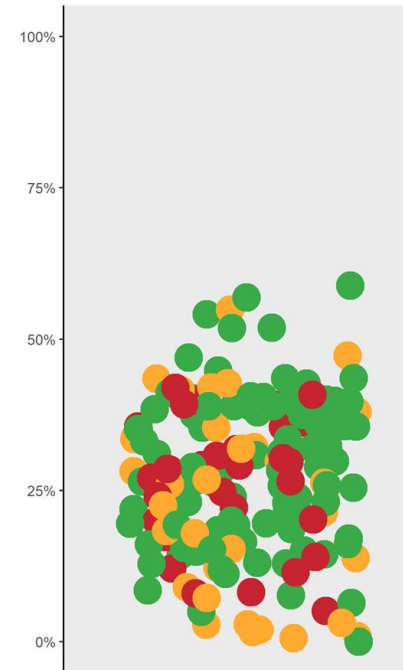

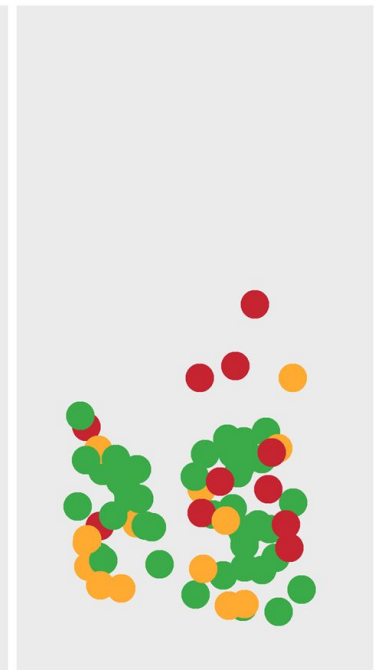

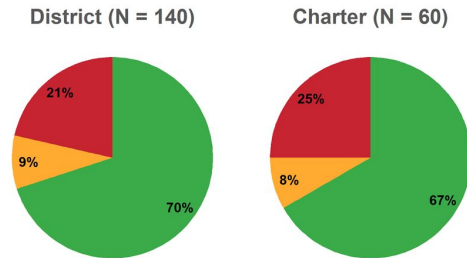

PSSA Math: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grade 3

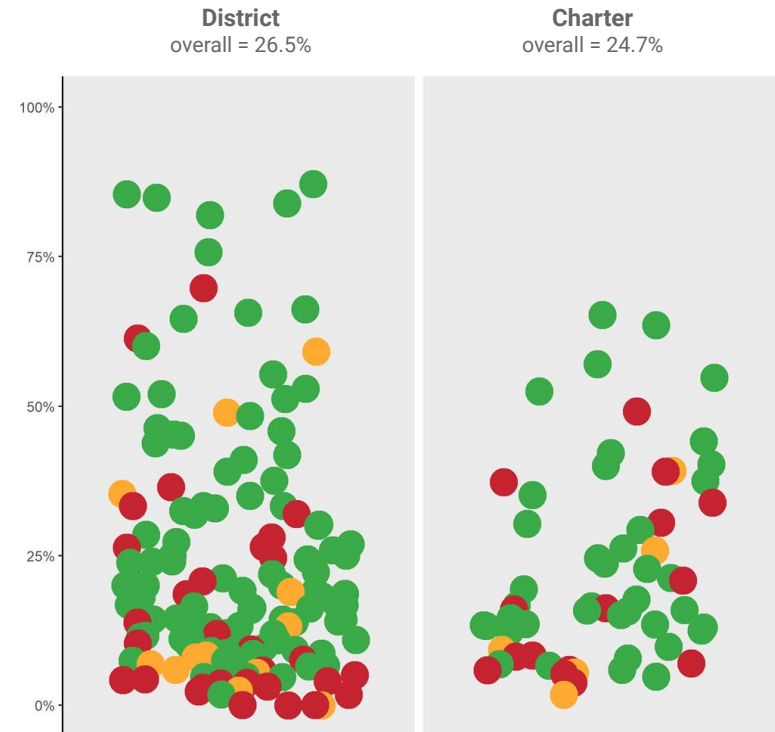

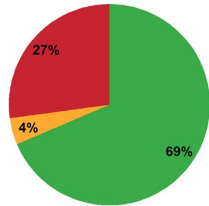

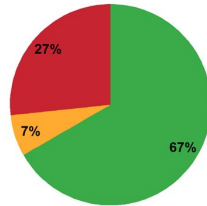
PSSA Math: Percentage of Students Scoring Below Basic, Grade 3

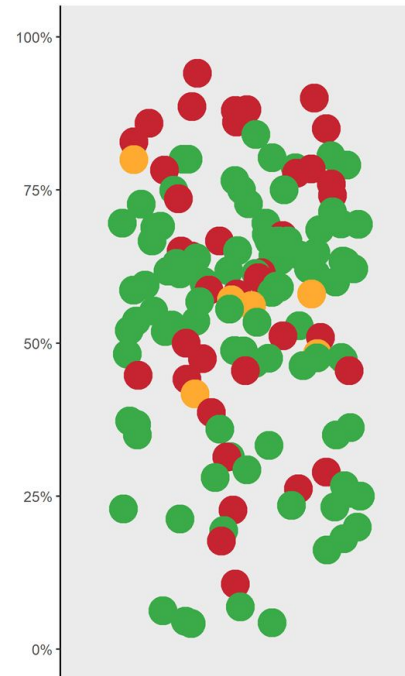

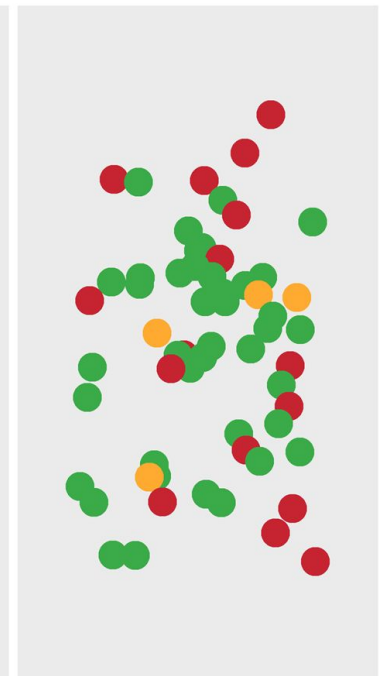

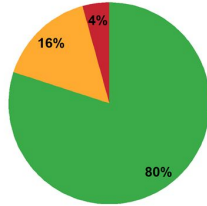
PSSA Math: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grades 3-8

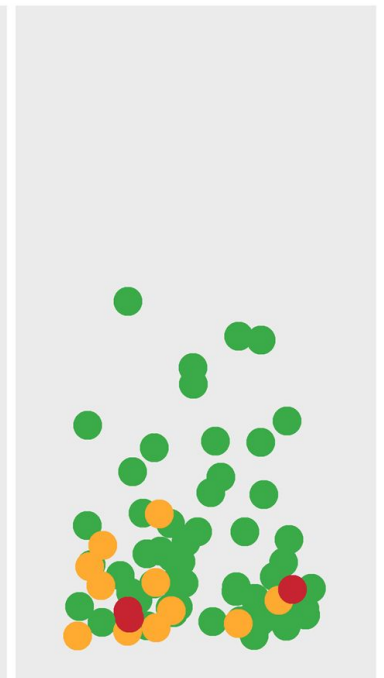

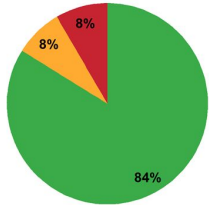

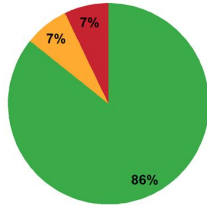
PSSA Math: Percentage of Students Scoring Below Basic, Grades 3-8

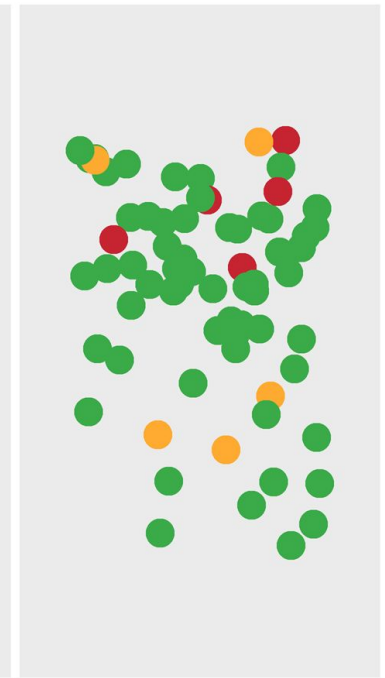

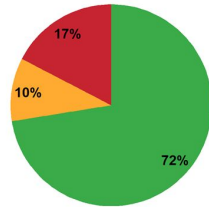
PSSA Science: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grades 4 & 8

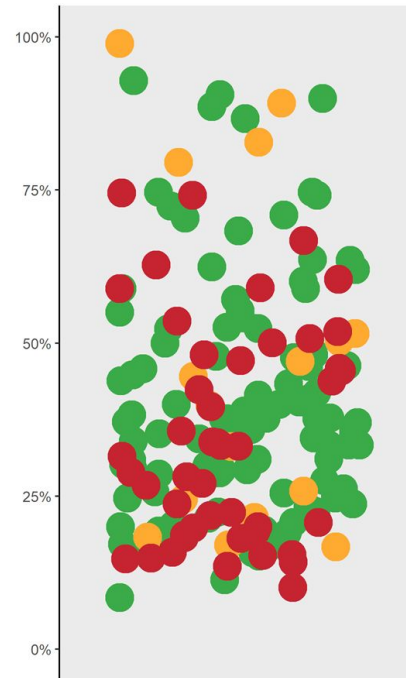


Percentage of students in grades 4 & 8 scoring Proficient or Advanced in 2022-23 by school

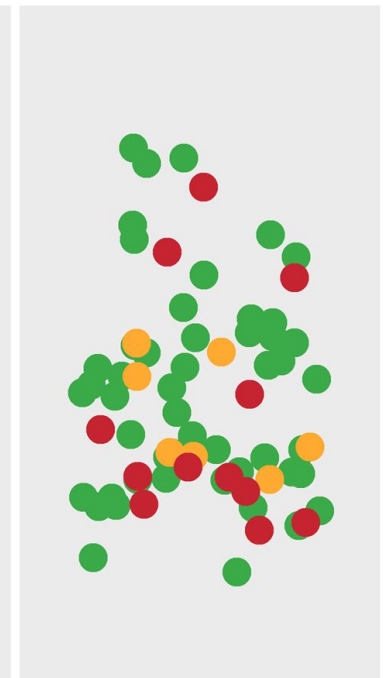

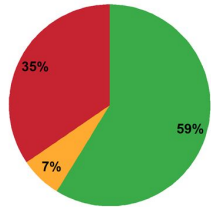

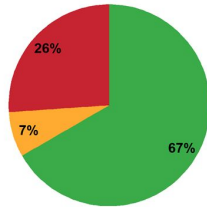
PSSA Science: Percentage of Students Scoring Below Basic, Grades 4 & 8

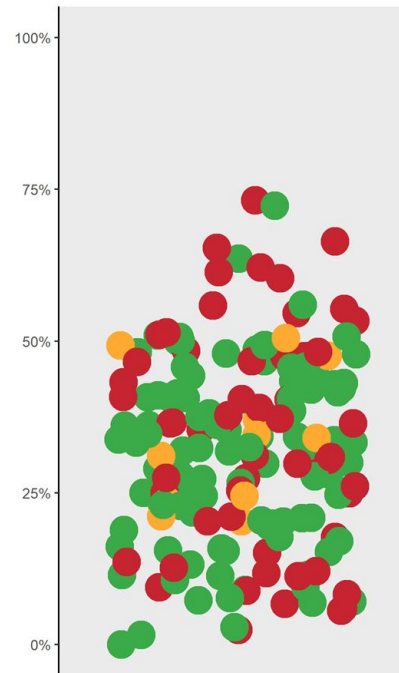

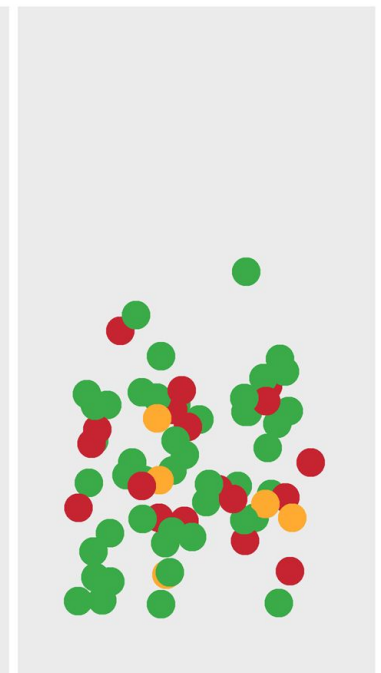

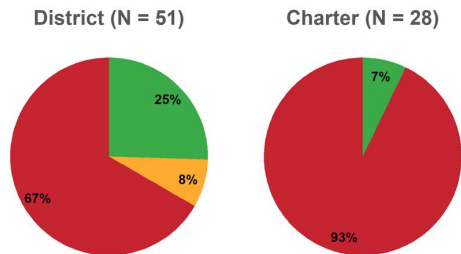

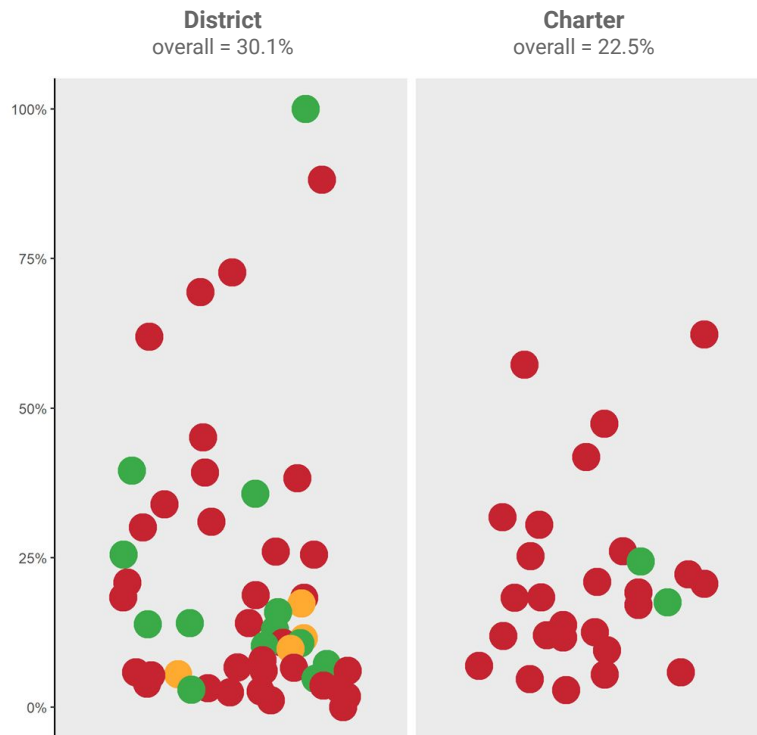
Keystone Algebra I: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grade 11

Percentage of school reports where Proficient/Advanced rates for students by grade 11 were **improving**, **maintaining**, or **not improving**



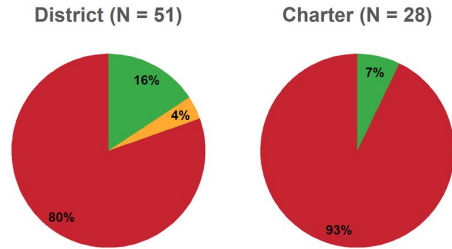

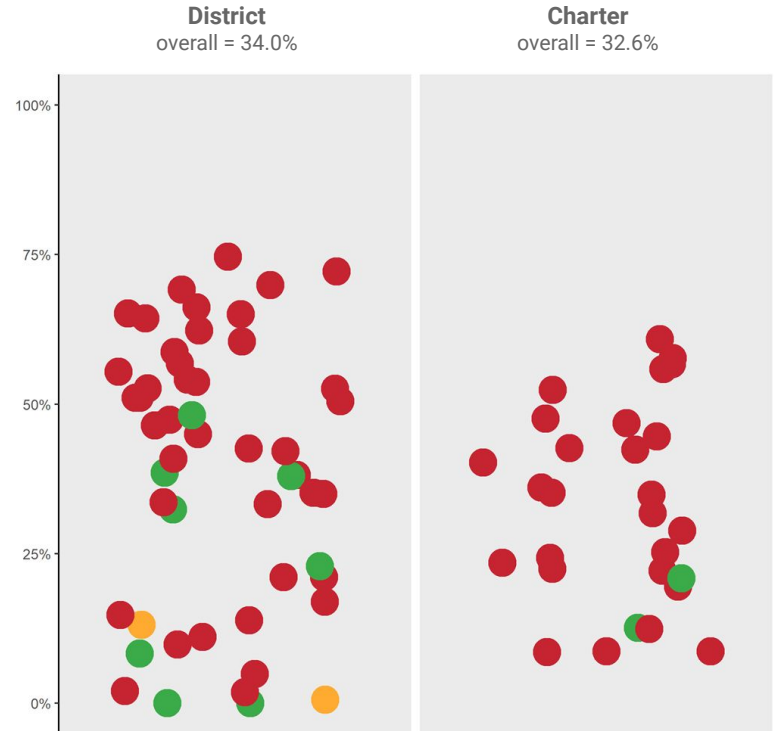
Keystone Algebra I: Percentage of Students Scoring Below Basic, Grade 11

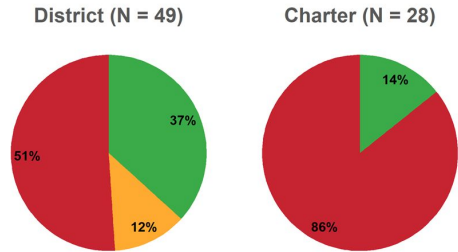

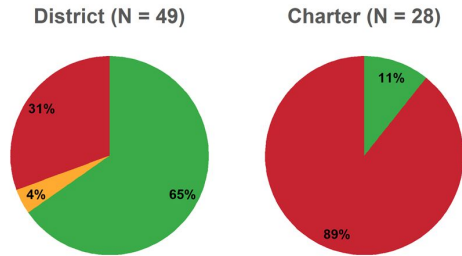

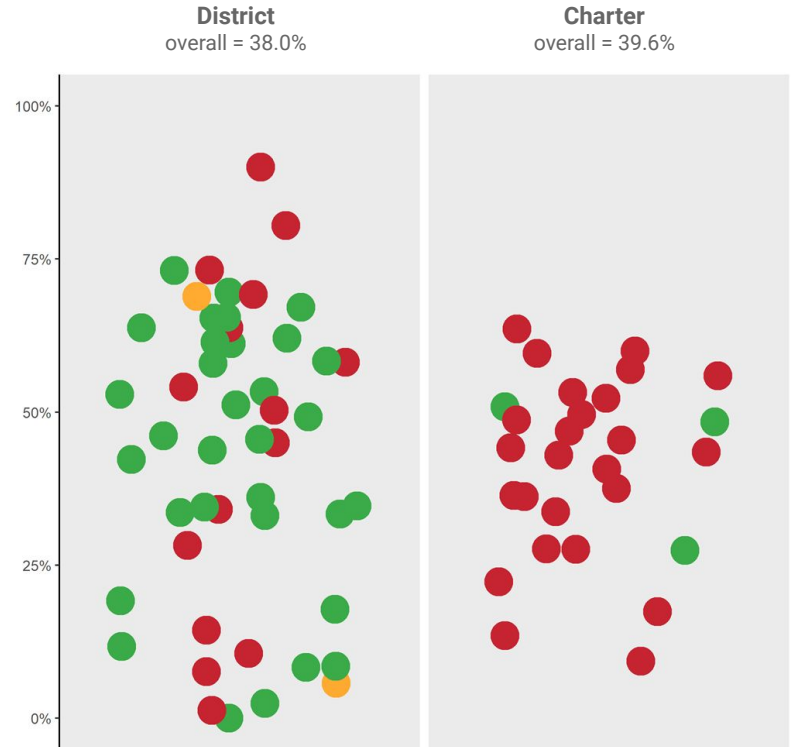

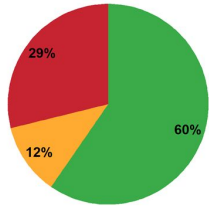

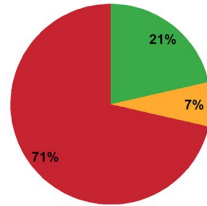
Keystone Literature: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced, Grade 11

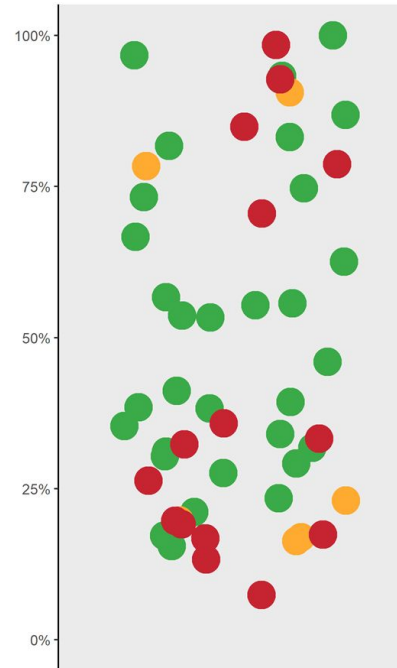


Percentage of students in 2022-23 who scored Proficient or Advanced by grade 11, by school

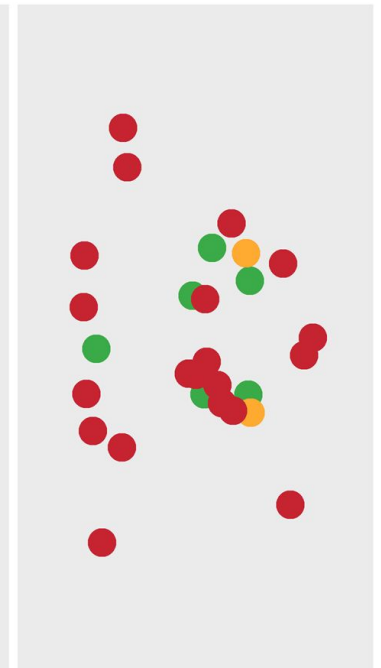

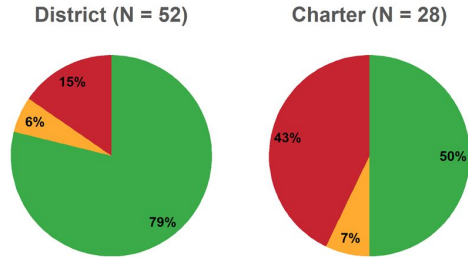

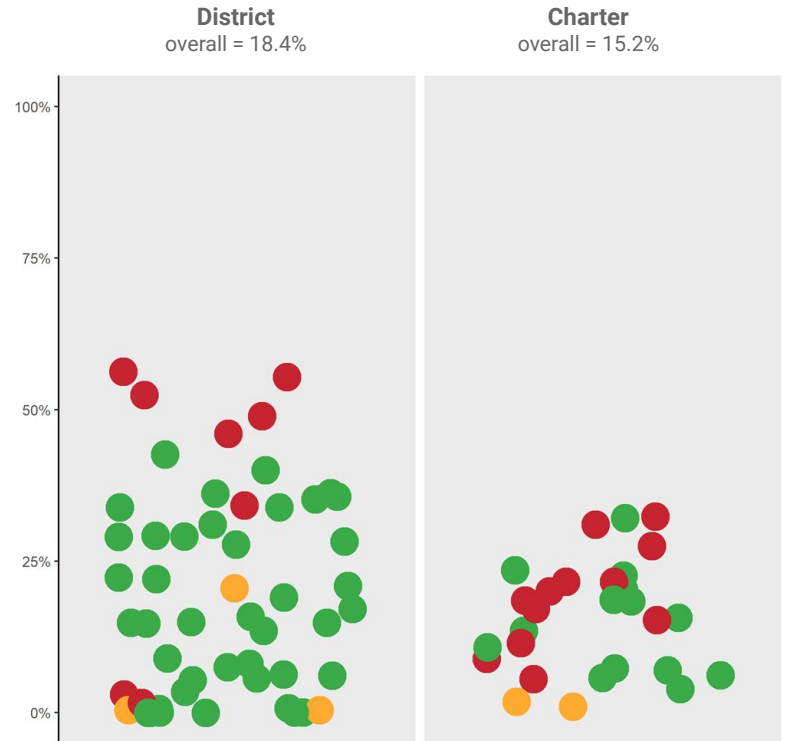

Percentage of school reports where the Below Basic rates for students by grade 11 were **improving**, **maintaining**, or **not improving**



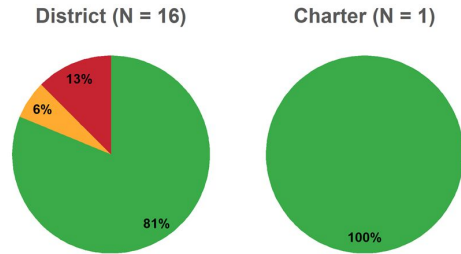

Percentage of CTE Students in Grade 12 Meeting Industry Standards

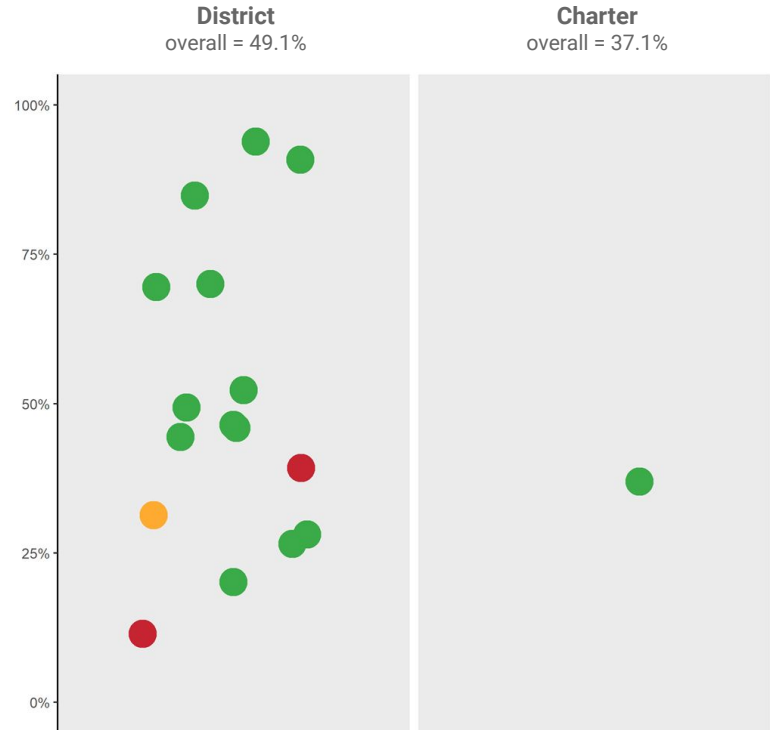
