What is PrimeGov?

PrimeGov is a web based platform that provides agenda automation, meeting management, community engagement, video streaming, and virtual meeting management for system users.

How will the Board of Education utilize the PrimeGov system?

The Board of Education will use PrimeGov to provide all stakeholders with user friendly access to all Board of Education public meeting materials including meeting agendas for both action and committee meetings, meeting

minutes, and access to meeting recordings that are currently available via PSTV and can be found by clicking here.

Will I still have access to materials that are currently in NovusAgenda?

Materials that are currently in NovusAgenda and accessible via the Board of Educations Meeting Materials webpage will be migrated to the new system. Stakeholders will be able to utilize the search feature in PrimeGov to access both current and past meeting materials dating back to 2018.

How is PrimeGov different from NovusAgenda?

Currently, users are able to download the meeting agenda as a pdf or there is an option to view the agenda in an online format. PrimeGov will provide users with an option to view meeting agendas in HTML format as well as PDF ultimately eliminating the need to click on individual action items to view items in detail.

How can I learn how to navigate the new system?

The Board of Education will have resources available online and in person at Board of Education Action Meetings to help ease the transition. Resources will include instructional videos like the one currently present on the Board website for NovusAgenda and training as the transition to the new system begins.
