

Creating a Tooltip Stepper

A message that appears when a cursor is positioned over specific text.


1.) Edit the page you would like the Tooltip to be placed on.




2.) Place the mouse cursor in the editor where you want the Tooltip text to be inserted.




3.) In the toolbar, click on the Tooltip icon (the icon resembles a "conversation bubble") on the first row of icons. It will then insert a shortcode (simple_tooltip) inside of the editor.



4.) To modify the content inside of the Tooltip, change the text within the single quotes inside of the shortcode. E.g. [simple_tooltip content='SAMPLE TOOLTIP TEXT'].



5.) To modify the content that appears on the page before the user triggers the Tooltip, change the text in between the opening and closing shortcode syntax. E.g. [simple_tooltip content='This is the content for the tooltip bubble']SAMPLE TEXT HERE[/simple_tooltip]



6.) Make sure to "Update" the page after the text has been changed.
